KC1		<p>Citizenship Gaining the knowledge, skills and understanding necessary to become informed, active and responsible global citizens.</p>
KC2		<p>Social Justice Understanding the importance of social justice as an element in both sustainable development and the improved welfare of all people.</p>
KC3		<p>Sustainable Development Understanding the need to maintain and improve the quality of life now without damaging our planet for future generations.</p>
KC4		<p>Diversity Understanding and respecting differences and relating these to our common humanity.</p>
KC5		<p>Values and Perceptions Developing a critical evaluation of images of the developing world and an appreciation of the effect these have on people's attitudes and values.</p>
KC6		<p>Interdependence Understanding how people, places and environments are all inextricably interrelated and that events have repercussions on a global scale.</p>
KC7		<p>Conflict Resolution Understanding how conflicts are a barrier to development and why there is a need for their resolution and the promotion of harmony.</p>
KC8		<p>Human Rights Knowing about human rights and understanding their breadth and universality.</p>
