

## DEP Global Dimension Teaching Resource Award 2010

### Produce a teaching resource and win a prize!

Development Education Project (DEP) is looking for resources produced by primary or secondary trainee teachers at Manchester Metropolitan University, for our Global Dimension Teaching Resource Award 2010. The resource should be one that enhances the teaching of the Global Dimension to the curriculum. It can be an activity, game or simulation, a scheme of work or a piece of action research that has been developed by one or more trainee teachers at MMU.

To qualify as a Global Dimension resource, it needs to fall within the following definition:

- The resource enhances skills and knowledge that enable understanding of the relationships between local, national and global affairs, focusing on one or more of the concepts of: interdependence, citizenship, diversity, sustainable development, social justice, values and perceptions, conflict resolution and human rights.
- The resource will promote the development of positive values and attitudes, and an outlook that encourages active participation, co-operation, respect for cultural diversity and democratic citizenship.
- The resource will challenge stereotypes, discrimination and social exclusion, and promote social inclusion.
- The resource will provide opportunities for active learning.
